








# The Wildfire Response Game

## Wildfire Response Guidelines

As the wildfire progresses, your community will face increasing risk. Use this guideline to think about what resources you need to respond to the changing situation.

Wildfire Levels	Immediate Actions	Secondary Actions
<b>Level 0</b> No Wildfire Risk 	Lowest wildfire risk, no action needed—address the <b>Community Challenge</b> .	
<b>Level 1</b> Low Wildfire Risk 	<p><b>Task a:</b> Send alert with <u>automated alert/notice system</u> via email, social media, reverse 911</p> <p><b>Task b:</b> <u>Volunteer teams</u> ready to move equipment to emergency coordination center</p> <p><b>Task c:</b> Confirm <u>alternate evacuation routes</u></p> <p><b>Task d:</b> <u>Emergency personnel</u> on alert and ready</p> <p><b>Task e:</b> Request additional <u>police officers</u> to be available with traffic redirection</p>	<p><b>Task f:</b> Have <u>road signs</u> or <u>road barricades</u> ready to deploy to fire-threatened roadways</p> <p><b>Task g:</b> <u>Volunteer team</u> ready to help with evacuation</p> <p><b>Task h:</b> Arrange <u>alternative school facilities</u></p> <p><b>Task i:</b> Ask the <u>emergency coordinator</u> to organize a neighborhood info meeting</p>
<b>Level 2</b> Moderate Wildfire Risk 	<p><b>Task a:</b> Send alert with <u>automated alert/notice system</u></p> <p><b>Task b:</b> Deploy <u>volunteer teams</u> to evacuate people and businesses in the wildfire zone</p> <p><b>Task c:</b> Move <u>industrial fire hose</u> to fire line</p> <p><b>Task d:</b> Use <u>road barricades</u> to close fire-threatened roads</p> <p><b>Task e:</b> Arrange <u>alternative school facilities</u></p>	<p><b>Task f:</b> Identify the closest <u>water reservoirs</u></p> <p><b>Task g:</b> Assemble <u>volunteer safety supplies</u></p> <p><b>Task h:</b> Coordinate a <u>volunteer team</u> to assist those who need help evacuating or protecting their homes</p> <p><b>Task i:</b> Use the <u>emergency shelter &amp; supplies</u> to temporarily replace a smoke-damaged daycare center</p>
<b>Level 3</b> High Wildfire Risk 	<p><b>Task a:</b> Send alert with <u>automated alert/notice system</u></p> <p><b>Task b:</b> Provide <u>volunteer safety supplies</u> to volunteers</p> <p><b>Task c:</b> Make <u>state emergency response request</u></p> <p><b>Task d:</b> Access city's <u>water reservoirs</u></p> <p><b>Task e:</b> Use a <u>volunteer team</u> to assist those who need help evacuating or protecting their homes</p>	<p><b>Task f:</b> Designate <u>alternative evacuation route</u></p> <p><b>Task g:</b> Set up <u>emergency shelters &amp; supplies</u> for residents that have to evacuate</p> <p><b>Task h:</b> Place <u>firefighting crews</u> on standby</p> <p><b>Task i:</b> Ask the <u>emergency coordinator</u> to address a neighborhood power outage</p>
<b>Level 4</b> Highest Wildfire Risk 	<p><b>Task a:</b> Send alert with <u>automated alert/notice system</u> with wildfire risk info and evacuation route</p> <p><b>Task b:</b> Coordinate <u>firefighting crews</u> to protect vulnerable homes</p> <p><b>Task c:</b> Activate <u>emergency shelters &amp; supplies</u></p> <p><b>Task d:</b> Activate <u>public transportation system</u> for assistance with evacuation</p> <p><b>Task e:</b> Activate secondary <u>volunteer teams</u> to support first responders (childcare, etc.)</p>	<p><b>Task f:</b> <u>Police officers</u> monitor roadways to ensure that evacuees can get out</p> <p><b>Task g:</b> Deploy additional <u>road signs</u> to help with increases in evacuation efforts</p> <p><b>Task h:</b> Deploy <u>medic team</u> to residents with smoke-related medical conditions</p> <p><b>Task i:</b> Get a <u>volunteer team</u> to move propane gas tanks from BBQs away from houses across your neighborhood</p>
